

PREPARATION CHECKLIST

Integrated Systems Using Telemedicine (ISUT)

Screening Process

- Determine if child is good fit for ISUT
 - Age, time needed for diagnosis, agreement between educational team and family about symptoms
 - If unsure, consult with Autism Diagnostic Team or provider

Information Needed from Autism Diagnostic Team

- Caregiver and/or educator report
 - Parent/guardian interview (e.g., CARS); student social behavior questionnaire
- Child-based assessments of social communication
 - Play-based interactions (e.g., ADOS)
 - Observations with peers in natural settings (recess, classroom, lunch)
- Brief background
 - Family history, development, education, health
- ISUT Telemedicine packet completed by family
- Supplemental information (if available)
 - Eligibility or re-evaluation report
 - Health/mental health records
 - Behavior rating scales, score summaries
- Determine if child should have educational identification of Autism
- Summary and Impressions



Preparing for Telemedicine Session

- Autism Diagnostic Team sends report to clinical team
- Coordinate appointment for interactive televideo interview

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ISUT Telemedicine Packet

Completed by Family, Assembled by Autism Diagnostic Team (ADT)

- Patient Intake Form
- Physician Referral Form from Primary Care Provider
- Patient Registration Form
- Copy of Insurance Card (both sides)
- Notice of Privacy Practice Acknowledgement Form
- Consent for Medical Treatment Form
- Financial Policy
- Patient Permission to Communicate with Designated Individuals
- Consent for Release of Confidential Information
- ADT Report
- Most Recent School Evaluation -- IEP, 504 Plan, IFSP
- Student Social Behavior Questionnaire -- Select Appropriate Age Range
 - Completed by teacher, early intervention specialist, or educational professional familiar with child
