Integrated Systems Using Telemedicine (ISUT)

Determining Fit for ISUT

- Communicate with family about process and reason for referral
- Determine if the child is an appropriate fit for diagnosis over telemedicine. Some children who should not be seen over telemed:
 - Very young children (<12 months); children with estimated developmental level of less than 12 months
 - Older children (e.g., teens) who don't want to participate in the encounter and won't answer questions
 - Families who want or need more than 60 minutes to feel confident in diagnosis
 - Children/teens where family and Autism Diagnostic Team (ADT) disagree about ISUT process or presence of ASD symptoms
- If unsure about child's fit, consult with ADT or provider

Evaluations

- Have toys available at site
- Ideally do not allow screen time (e.g., phone, tablet)
